HOW TO APPLY FOR ATT MEMBERSHIP

The Portal – which you will have become familiar with as a student – remains your central hub for applying for and managing your ATT membership.

- **Log in** to the Portal
- **Apply** to become a member
- **Pay your subscription** via the Portal

Once your payment is processed, you'll receive an invoice marked 'paid' by email. This can be used for expense reimbursement, where agreed with your employer.

To keep your membership active, you'll need to renew annually. Each November we'll send you a renewal notice by email, prompting you to pay your subscription for the year ahead and submit your Annual Return for the previous year.

Both your Annual Subscription and Annual Return are due by **31 January each year** and can be managed easily via the Portal.

UPHOLDING PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS AND AML SUPERVISION

ATT members commit to maintaining high professional standards, ensuring integrity, trust, and compliance in their work. The ATT is also a professional body AML supervisor, supporting members in meeting their anti-money laundering (AML) obligations.

Key professional standards

PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT IN RELATION TO TAXATION (PCRT):

The PCRT outlines the principles and standards of behaviour all members and students must follow in their tax work.

Developed by ATT, CIOT, and five other leading UK tax and accountancy bodies, it sets out the ethical code for the tripartite relationship between the adviser, the client, and the tax authorities. Recognised by HMRC and the courts, the PCRT ensures that tax advisers operate with integrity and professionalism.
