



TestReach Screen and Display tips

Welcome to this ATT tutorial video on how to set up your screen and display for your exam that will be conducted on TestReach.

You can only use a single screen during the examination.

3

00:00:19,120 --> 00:00:26,560

The single screen that you choose to use could be your laptop screen, in which case you must disconnect any other screens from the device.

If you have other screens on your desk, your TestReach proctor is likely to ask you to cover these for the duration of the exam. [For example, with a towel or a sheet.]

If you wish to use a larger screen than your laptop screen, you will need to close your laptop.

00:00:44,880 --> 00:00:50,160

This is because you are only allowed to use a single screen during the examination.

This means you will then need a separate webcam.

00:00:54,400 --> 00:00:59,840

This will need to be positioned in the centre of the screen on the top, as shown in the picture. [Webcam pictured fitted to centre top of screen.]

The size of your display and your display settings can impact how you see TestReach.

On this screen, I'm using a large screen. So we can see how I've opened the PDF copy of the question here, and I can see the full width of the question without having to change the scale settings at the top.

Similarly, if I look at the Croner legislation, I can see various settings at the top of the screen here.

If I look at the same screen on my laptop display, which is set to 150% scaling at the present time, I can't see all of the navigation in the Croner legislation.

And if I move to one of the PDF resources, such as the copy of the question, I won't be able to see this in full on the width of my screen.

00:02:02,720 --> 00:02:08,160

So here I would have to change the scale to be able to see the width of the question text here. [Using the scale / zoom buttons at the top of the PDF.]

15

00:02:10,639 --> 00:02:15,040

This can be resolved on my laptop screen by changing the scale settings.

16

00:02:16,240 --> 00:02:20,079

So if I go, on a Windows machine, to my display settings,

00:02:22,880 --> 00:02:30,560

and change the scale to 100%, it makes everything a bit smaller. [Accessing Display Settings on the computer.]

18

00:02:33,520 --> 00:02:46,560

If I now go back to my Test Reach screen, I can see that the scaling has changed so that I can see the full width of the PDF resource on the right-hand side at 100% scale without having to adjust the setting here.

19

00:02:49,760 --> 00:02:53,840

Similarly, I can see all of the functionality of the Croner legislation.

Before your exam, we recommend that you check how you plan to set up TestReach and the screen you intend to use.

You need to download the TestReach application using the link shown on screen.
