Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 covers the relevant legislation in relation to supply chains. It requires commercial organisations carrying out business in the UK with a turnover of at least £36m to prepare and publish a slavery and human trafficking statement. However, we would encourage all business to do this regardless of turnover.
